Metrics for 2024 at the year-end clean up

Purged – 62 member accounts showed no activity in three years. We have 30 nonfunctioning email addresses.

Keep-ask: 294 Members need to fill out their member form. Past Speakers, sponsors, and people who remain <u>active in our</u> online community but have yet to attend and earn ISC2 East Bay delivered CPE in the three-year cycle. We need affirmation to continue communications and invitations to speak at events.

Active ask: 299 active members must update their member form. ACTIVE: 207 members have been attending and have an up-to-date membership form



Moving to a model of Active Member v. Guest

The ISC2 East Bay Chapter is moving to a model of Active Member in Good Standing v. Guest to better support the operations of physical space and food management and to purchase scholarship and training materials.

The small annual fee, \$45, goes towards discounts and preferred access to for-pay events. Member guests may still use early bird incentives but will pay full rates to register and attend our conferences.

This change is less about increasing our revenue than it is about managing continuous spending for planned activities.

We also use this money to offset our policy of waiving fees for full-time students.






