2024 by the Numbers

We held 10 member meeting events.

We conducted two in-person conference events.

We coordinated with three organizations to enable free attendance to CPE recognized events.

Our membership earned 2445 hours of continuing professional education

330 out of 770 attendees hold at least one active ISC2 Certification and had their CPE posted to ISC2.org



Moving to a model of Active Member v. Guest

The ISC2 East Bay Chapter is moving to a model of Active Member in Good Standing v. Guest to better support physical space and food management operations and purchase scholarship and training materials.

The annual fee, \$45, goes towards discounts and preferred access to for-pay events. Member guests may still use early bird incentives but will pay full rates to register and attend our conferences.

This change is less about increasing revenue than managing continuous spending for planned activities.

We also use this money to offset our policy of waiving fees for full-time students.








